Title of Award: United School Employees of Pasco Scholarship Award Amount and

Type of Award:

A scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded to a high school **senior whose parent(s)/guardian(s) is/are a United School Employees of Pasco (USEP) member(s). Said member(s) must have maintained continuous membership in United School Employees of Pasco (USEP) for a minimum of two years.** The award is a grant and not subject to repayment.

Methods of Disbursement: Cash payment(s) will be made to the **institution** upon evidence of enrollment of the student in a qualifying institution. Cash payment may be used to help defray expenses of tuition, books and supplies.

Qualifying Institutions: Any community college, technical institute, college or university accredited by a regional accrediting association will qualify.

Qualifications:

- High School student has a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
- Student shares Special Awards and/or Achievements.
- Student has participated in extracurricular and/or community activities.
- Student has demonstrated leadership.
- Student can express him/herself well in writing.
- Two letters of Recommendation.

- Student whose parent(s) or guardian(s) is/are a member(s) of USEP.
- Additional credit may be given to those applicants who are pursuing a career in education.

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Application Deadline and Expectations:

- **Applications must be received in the USEP office no later than 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, April 18, 2023.**
- Mail (courier) or provide in person the "hard copy" of the completed scholarship application.
- Facsimiles or electronic mails (emails) will not be accepted. There are **NO exceptions.**
- Do NOT staple or bind materials. Paper clips are acceptable.
- Do NOT use covers or other decorative packaging. **Include ONLY materials requested.**
- **Five (5) copies of all application materials** must be submitted.
