## Filling Positions:

- Assignment to this program is voluntary.
- A member of administration will notify the staff of the program dates by May 11,2024 April 25 , 2022.
- Each employee having an interest in working in the program will submit his/her name to the administrator by May -18,2021 May 6, 2022.
- Tentative job openings will be announced by the last student day.
- When it is judged that professional qualifications and ability are substantially equal among applicants for the program to be offered, district seniority shall prevail.
- When filling positions, employees within the bargaining unit shall be given priority over other applicants.
- The previous procedure to select transportation employees for the school year assigrments will continue to be used, with the following exception. Bus drivers and transportation assistants who select a route and resign, or work less than half of the days of the selected route in ESY for the summer of 2020 2021, will be placed at the bottom of the selection list for ESY for the summer of 20212022 unless the reason for resigning or working less than half of the days is for one of the following reasons and is supported by appropriate documentation as determined by Transportation Department administration: a health concern that prohibits the employee from working or a health concern of an immediate family member of the employee and the employee is needed to care for the family member, family emergency, or jury duty.
